Why is Our Riparian Park so Special?

Riparian zones, or areas, are lands that occur along the edges of rivers, streams, lakes, and other water bodies. Less than .5% of Arizona land is riparian areas. **Click HERE** to learn more at the Arizona Riparian's Fact Sheet.

Our park's desert riparian habitat benefits both the bird and pollinator (like butterflies) life year around by increasing the diversity of food sources and by providing dense cover for nesting.
