EXHIBITOR GUIDELINES

Booth assignments:

- Specific booth need requests may be accommodated on a case-by-case basis.
- Booth assignments by the Black Canyon Heritage Park (BCHP) are final.

Electricity, Internet Connectivity and Wi-Fi:

- Electricity, telephone lines, and Internet connectivity are not available in the booth area.
- Exhibitors providing their own power and fuel <u>need to receive prior approval</u> from the event coordinator,
 Julie Forbis.

Vendor set up (loading and unloading)

- Set up hours are 8 AM to 10 AM on Saturday, January 31, 2026.
- Booths are expected to be open the full event (10 AM to 2 PM).
- Vehicles can be used to deliver and remove exhibit material before 9:30 AM and after 2 PM.
- Exhibitors are expected to take all their own property with them when the event concludes.
- All vehicles must remain out of the exhibit area during event hours 10 AM to 2 PM.
- Non-service trained pets are not allowed in the park.

Exhibit Space

- Booth locations and event layout are subject to change per the Event Coordinators.
- Bring your own tables, chairs, and shade cover (covers for sun and/or wind protection). If this presents a
 hardship, we have a few tables, chairs, and shade covers for rent.
- Please anchor your shade covers using weights (no stakes allowed) due to the possibility of wind event.
- Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that their booth, equipment, and all contents are presented and stored in a safe manner to avoid the risk of accidents or injury.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up any trash or debris at their booth area throughout the event. The Event Coordinators will provide trash cans in the exhibit area (recyclables and other).
- Smoking is allowed in designated areas only. We appreciate your cooperation.
- Exhibitors may not place flyers or coupons on cars in the parking area or walk around passing them out anywhere on the Black Canyon Heritage Park property.
- Pets are NOT allowed on the Black Canyon Heritage Park property.

Security:

The Black Canyon Heritage Park will have people helping with security issues during the exhibit hours.
 However, the Black Canyon Heritage Park is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damage to your exhibit space or its contents.
